Supplies Needed

(This tutorial contains affiliate links for your shopping convenience.)

- [EZ Bow Maker Tool](#)
- A variety of 1.5" wired ribbon (we use 3 different wired ribbons in this tutorial)
- [Scissors](#) (these are my favorites)
- [Wire Cutters](#) (yep - I love these too!)
- [8 inch Zip-ties](#)
- Chenille Stems or [Bind Wire](#)

Directions for Making a Loopy Wreath Bow

This bow formula makes a 12" wide bow with 12" streamers. You can choose either 2.5" wired ribbon or 1.5" wired ribbon.

Follow along with the video tutorial for up close instructions.

***Make sure to hold pressure on the middle of the bow as you work.
You don't want to lose all your hard work!***

Step One: Create the first layer of Streamers and Ribbon Loops

- Start with a 12" piece of ribbon for the first ribbon streamer (this is sometimes called a ribbon tail).
- Add ribbon into E-Z Bowmaker then begin to make 6" bow loops
- Create four 6" loops (two loops on each side on bowmaker tool)
- Finish this layer by cutting a 12" piece of ribbon for second tail

Step Two: Create the second layer of Streamers and Ribbon Loops

- Start with a 12" piece of ribbon for the first ribbon streamer (this is sometimes called a ribbon tail).
- Add ribbon into E-Z Bowmaker then begin to make 6" bow loops
- Create six 6" loops (three loops on each side on bowmaker tool)
- Finish this layer by cutting a 12" piece of ribbon for second tail

Step Three: Create the third layer of Streamers and Ribbon Loops

- Start with a 12" piece of ribbon for the first ribbon streamer (this is sometimes called a ribbon tail).
- Add ribbon into E-Z Bowmaker then begin to make 6" bow loops
- Create four 6" loops (two loops on each side on bowmaker tool)
- Finish this layer by cutting a 12" piece of ribbon for second tail

Step Four: Finish the Wreath Bow

- Fan out loops to form bow shape (watch tutorial to see how this is done)
- Slide a chenille stem (or bind wire) behind bow loops
- Slide an 8" zip tie behind bow loops (making sure to also catch the chenille stem)
- Use a zip-tie to loosely bind middle of bow (make sure to add chenille stem under loops)
- Carefully remove bow from the bowmaker tool
- Finish tightening the zip-tie to secure the bow
- Use fingers to "poof" out each bow loop

CONGRATS!

You just made a beautiful wreath bow that you can use to decorate your home for all seasons.
